



RIVER STOOL

Bones of the earth.

This stool sits somewhere between an object and an artefact. Shaped by nature over time, this stone originates from the riverbeds of a rural temple village. The grounding presence of this piece can be felt in its solid weight and organic form.

Function follows quietly. Used as a stool, side table, or sculptural plinth, it invites touch and pause, offering stability through its mass. Each piece is entirely unique, defined by natural variations in tone, texture, and surface markings.

Aside from a polished, level top surface, this stool is largely untouched to honour the integrity of the material. Weighing in at more than 100 kg, this river stool is a piece of the earth transported from another place and time.
